Impacts of No Change & Adding 15 minutes

No Change

- No money from DPS for ELT schools (\$96,000)
- No access to grant opportunities afforded to ELT schools
- .5 Literacy Interventionist versus 1.0 Literacy Interventionist
- No opportunity to make-up Title I loss: \$74,095 RIBS (1.12 FTE)
 - May not be able to fund 5 specialists needed to ensure common collaboration time for staff

Additional 15 minutes

- Opportunity to make-up Title I loss (\$74,095)
- Would seek DPS ELT funding for:
 - .5 Interventionist funding (\$33,000) for 1.0 interventionist (.5 funded by school improvement grant)
 - FTE to fund all 5 specialist teachers (\$66,000)
 - Additional funds to ensure or increase funding for elementary paraprofessionals
 - Additional funds for teachers extrapay for providing intervention and/or enrichment opportunities
- Would have access to grant opportunities afforded to ELT schools
