6. Budget- Evan Mellman
  - a. Rules and restrictions about money from Mill Levy for ECE-3 literacy efforts were revised
    - i. Guidelines about how money is spent are dictated by DPS
      1. In the midst of budget decisions, the Budget Team released funds from required Professional Development to the school budget
      2. School is able to use money more flexibly
      3. Waiver approved for full-time psychologist to be reduced to four days a week
