- Minutes approved
- Celebrations- FDM has 4 new members, totaling 9. Denison is part of 2nd round bond levy and will get additional funds. Primary families are going on a hike in October. Caroline is great as the Family Liaison. Garlic Knot Night- hugely successful. Spirit week was also great.
- CSC training
 - UIP- Unified Improvement Plan training (Power Point). UIP's goal is to align efforts to ensure that all students exit school ready for college and/or career. 2 year strategic plan. Data available on CDE website.
 - SPF- School Performance Framework. Comes out October 9th. School report card. Aligns district goals, state requirements, federal mandates. Looks at a 2 year average in each of the indicators.
 - School budget- students x per student base = SBB allocation. Budget CSC meeting will be in February.
- SAM PD- How do principals spend their time? SAM meets daily with principal to identify school first responders, reflect on impact, schedule instructional leadership time. Utilizes the Time Track calendar.
- Exit interviews- Scott's topic. Will move to next month's meeting.
- CMAS data- comparison of scores at like schools. FRL category has the largest gap in scores. Also a large gap for students of color. 0% of ELLs met expectations in math or ELA. Kinder, 1st and 2nd graders will be doing the iReady assessment so that data can be obtained at an earlier age. 3 times a year- beginning, middle and end of year. How do we lift up the positives?
- Need to add equity as a major improvement strategy. District will come out to do an equity scan- curriculum, culture and climate, etc. Will deliver a report that will be supported by the district.
